

## 2012 Estate Pinot Noir Green Valley Russian River Valley

Every so often everything aligns in the growing season and the results exceed all expectations. 2012 was such a year; very long cool growing season with no heat spikes, no disease pressure, large crop fully matured. We harvested our Pinot almost a full month later than usual without any signs of over ripeness.

The resulting wine is a classic Russian River Pinot – Great clarity of fruit, with a rich underlying earthiness, this wine has a long life ahead. Layers of pomegranate and blueberry mingled with mineral and spice evolve with each sip. Silky on the palate, with a long slightly peppery finish. A balance of fruit, tannin and acidity allows this wine to pair well with food in addition to drinking beautifully on its own.
