

2010 Pinot Noir Rio Vida Lane Russian River Valley

Rio Vida Lane is tucked among world famous viticulture sites near Vine Hill Road, home to some of the Russian River Valley's earliest Pinot Noir plantings. This little gem of a vineyard is meticulously dry farmed in a region cooler than most nearby growing areas, producing a Pinot that is balanced, bright and lean, with supple tannins and a distinct fruit profile.

Vinified with native yeasts, it contains only minimal sulfites and has been bottled unfined and unfiltered. Aged in neutral French oak for 32 months.
